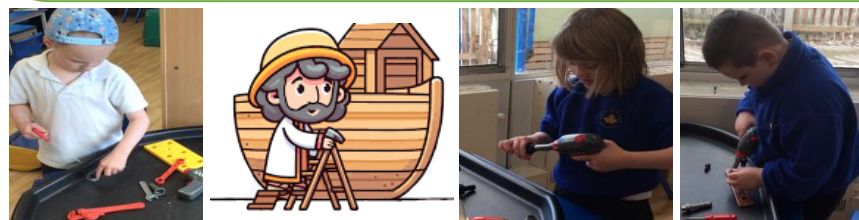
★ Highlights of the Week: ★
