Winter Snow Globe

You will need:

- · A small glass jar
- Glitter
- Strong glue
- Blue food colouring (optional)
- Water
- Variety of different colours of polymer clay
- Elastic band





Instructions



1 First, use the polymer clay to mould a character to go into the snow globe (use the upturned lid from the jar as a size guide). Bake the polymer clay according to its instructions.



2 Now, prepare the snow globe itself. To do this, first put a teaspoon of glitter into the jar and fill the jar with water to around 1cm from the top.



3 Put a small blob of strong glue onto the middle of the lid and allow it to go tacky.

Then, stick the model onto the lid. Leave it to dry thoroughly.

To change the colour of the water, add a few drops of blue food colouring. You should now have glittery blue water!



7 Firmly tighten the lid on to the jar. Once completely sealed, turn the jar so that it sits on the lid and watch the snow storm around the character inside!



6 Put a tight elastic band around the bottom half of the thread on the jar. Then, turn the lid updide down and gently lower it into the jar.





Winter Snow Globe



You will need:

- A small glass jar
- Glitter
- Strong glue
- Blue food colouring (optional)

- Different coloured polymer clay
- Elastic band







Step 1. First, use the polymer clay to mould a character to go into the snow globe (use the upturned lid from the jar as a size guide). Bake the polymer clay according to its instructions.

Step 4. To change the colour of the water, add a few drops of blue food colouring. You should now have glittery blue water!





Step 5. Put a tight elastic band around the bottom half of the thread on the jar. Then, up turn the lid so that the polymer clay character is upside down and gently lower it into the jar.





Step 6. Gently but firmly, tighten the lid on to the jar. Once completely sealed, turn the jar so that it sits on the lid and watch the snow storm around the character inside!
