

Learning time seemed to be a favourite with most of the children this week. We explored lots of different cause and effect toys and looked at pictures of ourselves and peers in a Maple Class 2024 book. We also practiced our role play skills with play food, although this usually ended in water play at the sink with all the cups and plates!

During sounds time we tried some new mark making using the interactive whiteboard including changing the colour and making shapes. We also enjoyed using playdough with rollers and shape cutters or squashing it with our hands, a great fine motor activity.

In number time we tried some inset puzzles and non-inset puzzles, some children could find the two pieces needing support to push them together.

We also explored shape sorters, filling and emptying them with the shapes and hidden objects through chick shape toys.
