Learning Notes:

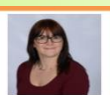
- In English this week we have worked on individual targets, looking at word functions and grammar targets.

Class Messages:

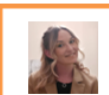
- We have sent home PE kits but please can they be returned for the first Monday back after half term as this is one of our PE days.
